To qualify for A/L's, a minimum of 6 passes with three (3) C passes and passes in Sinhala/Tamil Language, Mathematics and English are required. Please read the information below very carefully before selecting the subjects.

1. Students must offer six subjects, of which three subjects could be of their own choice selected from courses available in school and three compulsory subjects. The other three subjects are General English, and Common General Test and General Information Technology (GIT).
2. Students who have not obtained the minimum requirements specified for $\mathrm{A} / \mathrm{L} \mathrm{s}$ will not be admitted to the $\mathrm{A} / \mathrm{L}$ class.
3. Students who have failed Math are not permitted to do A/L's at school.
4. To do Commerce / Biological or Physical Science in the English medium the student should possess an "A" Pass for English or should have studied in the English Medium.
5. To follow subjects in the Biological or Physical Science Stream for A/L's the students should have obtained:
$\begin{array}{llll}\text { For Biological Science } & - & A n \\ \text { "A" pass in Science and at least a "B" pass in Math. } \\ \text { For Physical Science } & - & \text { An "A" pass for Math and at least a "B" pass for Science }\end{array}$
6. To follow the Commerce Stream at least a " C " Pass is required both in Math and Business Studies.
7. To study Business Statistics at least a "B" Pass is required in Math
8. To follow Economics in the Arts Stream (English/Sinhala) at least a "C" pass is required in Math.
9. To follow ICT at least a 'C' pass is required in Math. (Students who have not offered ICT for O/L's will not be permitted to offer ICT for A/L's)
10. If students wish to offer English Literature as a subject for A/Levels, they should have obtained an 'A' Pass in English Language and a 'C' Pass for English Literature (students who have not offered English Literature for O/L's will not be permitted to offer English Literature for A/L's.
11. If students wish to offer French as a subject for A/Levels, they should have obtained a ' $\mathbf{C}$ ' Pass for French. (Students who have not offered French for O/L's will not be permitted to offer French for A/L's)
12. Students are permitted to offer subjects privately, only if such subjects are not in the curriculum at school. However, at all times we prefer students to select subjects which are in the school curriculum.
13. Students are permitted to change subjects only till end of the $\mathbf{1 s t}$ Term in the $\mathbf{A} / \mathbf{L}$ class. If a student does not have $80 \%$ attendance specified by the Education Department, such a student will not be permitted to sit the last term test and the withdrawal exam conducted by the school.
